Frequently asked questions

1. Can I register even if I don't present a job?

Answer: YES

2. Can I sign up if I am a member of the IAU?

Answer: YES

3. Can I submit a paper without being a member of the IAU?

Answer:

YES, the work will be evaluated by the Scientific Committee, there will be no differentiated evaluation, that is, if the work is good, relevant and passes the COC evaluation, it will be presented.

4. It is possible to register for the symposium without being an astronomer, being a teacher, teacher student, amateur, interested, etc.

Answer: YES

4. Can I attend public conferences or workshops or round tables without being registered?

Answer:

- In the case of conferences for the public, in principle, YES, but we will evaluate the possibility of a minimum registration, to know how many people attend, from where they come from, among other statistical matters.
- If it is workshops (those that are in the afternoon, almost against shift): no, because the workshops require interaction. There you have to register. We will publish the information about the workshops soon.
- If it is the round table on inclusion: for the moment it is not necessary to register, but the organizers have not yet decided on the dynamics
